

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS, RENAMING A PORTION OF SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> STREET TO PRESTON ROAD, WITHIN GUNTER'S CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, SAVINGS & REPEALING CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Gunter, Texas ("Gunter") has initiated a request to rename a portion of SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> Street to Preston Road, within the Gunter city limits, (see Exhibit "A"), in Gunter, Grayson County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Gunter, Texas ("City Council"), has investigated into and determined that it will be advantageous and beneficial to Gunter and its inhabitants to rename a portion of SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> Street to Preston Road, within the Gunter city limits, as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Renaming SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> Street. The name of SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> Street is hereby renamed to Preston Road, within the Gunter city limits. All ordinances and plats of Gunter referring to SH 289/8<sup>th</sup> Street, within the Gunter city limits, are amended to Preston Road and said ordinances and plats shall otherwise remain in full force and effect. The general location of the street name change is depicted on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 3: Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Gunter hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that anyone or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.


SECTION 4: Savings/Repealing Clause. All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption.

EXTENT OF AREA TO BE OFFICIALLY DESIGNATED AS PRESTON ROAD

All that area within the right-of-way of State Highway 289, also known as Eighth Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Gunter, from one-half mile south of FM Highway 902 southward to 0.7 miles north of the south boundary of Grayson County.
