

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-10-15-03

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS; AMENDING ARTICLE 1.03, CITY COUNCIL, CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 2, SECTION 1.03.002, DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, SAVINGS AND REPEALING CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gunter, Texas ("City Council") has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens to change the date of the meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: FINDINGS INCORPORATED. The findings set forth above are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 1.03 (CITY COUNCIL), CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 2, SECTION 1.03.002 (DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS) OF THE GUNTER CODE OF ORDINANCES. Article 1.03 (City Council), Chapter 1, Division 2, Section 1.03.002 (Date, Time and Place of Meetings) of the Gunter Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

The city council hereby determines that the city council shall have its regular meetings on the third Thursday of each calendar month. When appropriate, the mayor or mayor pro tem may instruct the city secretary not to schedule and post a regular meeting, including but not limited to when the meeting would fall during the holidays, when it is known that a quorum will not be available or when there is not sufficient city business to warrant a meeting. Additional meetings of the city council may be scheduled as deemed appropriate and in accordance with state law. The exact time and location for each meeting shall be posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

The remainder of this article shall be unchanged.

SECTION 3: SAVINGS/REPEALING: Ordinance No. 2017-02-09-01 is hereby repealed. All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY: Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, illegal or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall

remain in full force and effect. Gunter hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon and after its passage.
