

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS, REQUIRING CONTRACTORS OPERATING IN THE CITY OF GUNTER TO REGISTER; ESTABLISHING A REGISTRATION FEE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, SAVINGS & REPEALING CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gunter, Texas (“Gunter”) has determined that protection of the health and safety of the citizens of the city requires that contractors working inside the city register with the City and describe the work they will be performing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a fair and reasonable charge may be imposed for the work of the City staff in administering the registration process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTER, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Contractors Required to Register with City. Every contractor and subcontractor performing work within the corporate limits of the City of Gunter is required to register with the City prior to performing said work, including providing a description of the work to be performed.

SECTION 3: Administrative Fee. An administrative fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be assessed to every contractor registration.

SECTION 4: Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Gunter hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4: Savings/Repealing Clause. All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption and approval.


